

Summary of IPCT Proposals Endorsed May 2025 (Round 1)

West Carleton Family Health Team (FHT) led a proposal in partnership with Richmond Medical Clinic, Ottawa Valley FHT, Arnprior & District FHT, Western Ottawa Community Resource Centre (WOCRC), and Rideauwood Addiction and Family Services (RAFS) for a collaborative expansion of interprofessional primary care services. This multi-organizational proposal for attachment focused in K0A, with support of partners spread across various communities in the western and southern areas of K0A.

The proposal seeks to expand existing FHT models, leveraging a robust partnership network to attach 8,500 net new patients by March 2027, with 1,500 patients attached within the first three months of funding. The team will work to address barriers faced by those impacted by social determinants of health. Targeted outreach, flexible care models, and partnerships with organizations like RAFS and WOCRC will ensure no patient is left behind.

Partners will deliver interdisciplinary, team-based care by optimizing the scope of Nurse Practitioners, Physician Assistants, allied health professionals, and administrative staff. Strong partnerships with community, social services, hospitals, and the OWFR OHT & PCN will promote integrated care pathways, ensuring seamless transitions and holistic patient support.

Ottawa West Four Rivers OHT and West Carleton FHT also offered a letter of support and coordination for Great River OHT’s round 1 collaborative proposal, which will address needs in a more eastern area of K0A (in addition to their high priority FSAs). Their proposal seeks to attach approximately 1,890 net new francophone patients by increasing capacity in their francophone Community Health Centre (Centre de santé communautaire de l’Estrie) whose offices are currently located in the eastern part of K0A.

Greenbelt Family Health Team’s expansion plan is primarily focused within K2J and K2G. This plan provides attachment of 900 net new patients within the first three months, 6,800 patients attached by March 2027 and over 9,800 patients attached within three years using a coordinated and multi-pronged approach—focused on internal wait-list management, Health Care Connect referrals, strategic community partnerships, and phased recruitment. With collaborative initiatives in place, Greenbelt FHT will continue to work to systematically connect patients with the most appropriate primary care providers in our region.

South Nepean Community Health Centre (SNCHC), satellite site of Pinecrest Queensway Community Health Centre (PQCHC), put forward and expansion of their existing team in collaboration with two additional primary care practices (Rideau Valley Health Services and Ideal Wellness Clinic). Together, these teams propose to attach 2,500 net new patients within 3 months and 13,000 in total by March 2027. This proposal also further builds the capacity of Nepean Rideau Osgoode Community Resource Centre (NROCRC), Britannia Woods Community Services, and Jewish Family Services Ottawa, each recognized for delivery of high-quality mental health services, to provide accessible, culturally sensitive, multi-language mental health services for primary care clients attached within the K2G and K2J and will include access to consultative psychiatric support for primary care providers.

The decision was made to submit two separate, but coordinated, proposals addressing attachment of K2G and K2J residents. Both proposals indicated their commitment to collaboration through a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to optimize equitable patient assignment.
