General Background

Ottawa West Four Rivers OHT was also pleased to learn that **three forward sortation areas (FSAs) (1st three digits of postal code) attributed to our OHT, are including in this call out **K2G, K2J, and K0A****. Primary care practices and clinicians who provide care to people living in these FSAs are eligible to submit proposals for funding consideration through the Ottawa West Four Rivers OHT/PCN. Please note: each OHT in the province can only submit one proposal per FSA (3 in total for Ottawa West Four Rivers OHT). Proposals are due to the Ministry **May 2, 2025**.
